GENERAL RULES FOR EXHIBITORS

1. All sanctioned classes are open to Jack Russell Terriers only.
2. Exhibitors and owners of terriers entered must be current JRTCA members, and must not be a member of a conflicting JRT organization or register their JRTs in any all-breed registry or conflicting JRT organization registry. If an exhibitor is found to be in violation of this policy, entry will be disqualified and no refunds given. If a violation is confirmed after the trial, placements will be voided from all JRTCA records. Exhibitors must submit a completed entry form including a signed waiver for every trial they enter.
3. Entries MUST be within the 10 – 15” JRTCA height standard for all sanctioned classes (with the exception of pups who have not yet met the 10” height standard); measuring devices will be available on the trial grounds.
4. Puppies (under 12 months of age) are not eligible for a championship in any division but their own. Puppies are eligible to compete only if they have reached their four-month birthday (not 16 weeks). A puppy’s age is the actual age the pup is on the day of the trial.
5. Bitches in season may not compete in any division. Pre-entry fees of bitches in season to be refunded with a vet certificate from owner, or as otherwise agreed upon by the Trial Chairperson.
6. Spayed or neutered terriers may compete in Miscellaneous Conformation. They may not compete in Puppy, Family, Open or Working Conformation.
7. A terrier bred by a sanctioned JRTCA Judge may not be shown under that Judge in the conformation division.
8. Terriers owned or co-owned by the Trial Chairperson, or any member of their household, may not be entered in any phase of the competition, with the exception of Child and Youth Handling.
9. Terriers owned by judges may not be entered in the division in which they are judging, but may enter the competition in any other division.
10. Terriers owned by stewards may be entered in any division provided that they find a substitute to perform their duties or have someone else show their terriers.
11. Requests for the measurement of a terrier being shown in any class may be made only by another exhibitor in that class or by the Judge. These measurements will be considered the official height of the terrier in question. Requests made by spectators will not be honored. Only JRTCA height cards issued after September 1999 will be honored.
12. Excessive use of squeaky or fur-like baiting devices by exhibitors is prohibited in the Conformation ring and may result in the exhibitor being excused from the class. “Excessive use” will be at the judge’s discretion.
13. Exhibitors participating in the JRTCA Working Terrier classes or Certificate Go-to-Ground must submit the appropriate JRTCA certificates with pre-entries or at the time of post-entry. The Judge may require a copy of the certificate be presented to the ring/den steward at the time of judging. Registered terriers may submit a copy of NHC application signed by a JRTCA Working Judge within 30 days of the date it was issued.
14. Puppies under the age of three months are not permitted on the trial grounds. Any person violating this rule will be excused from all classes entered, and asked to leave the trial site.
15. All dogs must be leashed or crated except when competition requires off leash work. No liberty leashes allowed.
16. Overly aggressive dogs or an owner’s failure to control his/her dog, may result in disqualification at the discretion of the judges or the Trial Chairperson.
17. The abuse or severe disciplining of dogs on the trial grounds is prohibited. Anyone displaying such behavior will be asked to leave the trial site, and no entry fees will be refunded.
18. Dogs, other than JRT’s, on the grounds may be excluded or permitted at the discretion of the Trial Chairperson.
19. Exhibitors are responsible to double-check the classes they have entered and be on time. No refunds will be given for missed classes.
20. The owner/handler of a terrier entering any class does so at his/her own risk and agrees to abide by the rules of the JRTCA and the trial. A copy of the JRTCA Rule Book can be obtained by contacting the JRTCA office (410-561-3655) or it can be downloaded from the JRTCA web site (www.terrier.com).
21. Unsportsmanlike conduct, or the use of foul and abusive language, will not be tolerated. Anyone demonstrating such conduct will be asked to leave the trial site and no entry fees will be refunded. In addition, such conduct will be subject to penalties, which may include the suspension of membership, restriction from entering the JRTCA National Trial, and/or fines. Trial Chairpersons have the right to refuse any entry at their discretion.
22. **THE JUDGES’ DECISIONS CONCERNING PLACEMENTS ARE FINAL IN ALL DIVISIONS!**

Your JRTCA registration /recording number is required as of Jan 1st, 2010 on your entry form.
If your terrier is not registered or recorded there will be a \$5.00 JRTCA fee per day per dog.

DIGGIN WEST Presents THREE GENERATION OF WORKING TERRIERS

Division A - Conformation

Section 1. JRTCA Working Terrier Conformation - *Open to any JRTCA registered terrier owned by a JRTCA member which holds a JRTCA Natural Hunting Certificate. Terriers entering the Working Section **may not** cross-enter into the Open Section; no cross-entering is permitted within the Working Section. Classes may be combined by height and coat type at the Trial Chairpersons discretion.*

- Class 1: Bronze Medallion Dogs —*Open to any dog which has earned the JRTCA Bronze Medallion for Special Merit in the Field.*
- Class 2: Bred by Exhibitor Working Terrier Dog. *Open to any Working Jack Russell Terrier owned and bred by the exhibitor under whose kennel prefix the terrier is registered; must be handled by the breeder or a member of the breeder's immediate family.*
- Class 3: Working Terrier Dog, 10 up to 12½", smooth.
- Class 4: Working Terrier Dog, 10 up to 12 ½", rough/broken.
- Class 5: Working Terrier Dog, over 12½ up to 15", smooth.
- Class 6: Working Terrier Dog, over 12½ up to 15", rough/broken.
- Class 7: Best Working Terrier Dog & Reserve.** *Open to 1st and 2nd place winners of classes 1 through 6. No entry fee.*
- Class 8: Bronze Medallion Bitch—*Open to any bitch which has earned the JRTCA Bronze Medallion for Special Merit in the Field.*
- Class 9: Bred by Exhibitor Working Terrier Bitch. *Open to any Working Jack Russell Terrier owned and bred by the exhibitor under whose kennel prefix the terrier is registered; must be handled by the breeder or a member of the breeder's immediate family.*
- Class 10: Working Terrier Bitch, 10 up to 12½", smooth.
- Class 11: Working Terrier Bitch, 10 up to 12½", rough/broken.
- Class 12: Working Terrier Bitch, over 12½ up to 15", smooth.
- Class 13: Working Terrier Bitch, over 12½ up to 15", rough/broken.
- Class 14: Best Working Terrier Bitch & Reserve.** *Open to 1st and 2nd place winners of classes 8 through 13. No entry fee.*
- Class 15: WORKING TERRIER CONFORMATION CHAMPION & RESERVE.** *Open to Best Working Terrier Dog & Reserve and Best Working Terrier Bitch & Reserve. No entry fee.*

Section 2. 4 up to 6 Month Puppy Conformation

- Class 16: Dog Pups, 4 up to 6 months, smooth.
- Class 17: Dog Pups, 4 up to 6 months, rough/broken.
- Class 18: **Best & Reserve 4-6 months Dog Pup,** *Open to 1st and 2d place winners of classes 16 & 17.*
- Class 19: Bitch pups, 4 up to 6 months, smooth.
- Class 20: Bitch pups, 4 up to 6 months, rough/broken.
- Class 21: **Best & Reserve 4-6 months Bitch Pup,** *Open to 1st and 2d place winners of classes 19 & 20.*
- Class 22: Best 4 up to 6 Month Puppy & Reserve.** *Open to the 1st and 2nd place winners of classes 18 & 21. No entry fee.*

Section 3. 6 - 12 Month Puppy Conformation

- Class 23: Dog pups, 6 up to 9 months, smooth.
- Class 24: Dog Pups, 6 up to 9 months, rough/broken.
- Class 25: Dog Pups, 9 up to 12 months, smooth.
- Class 26: Dog Pups, 9 up to 12 months, rough/broken.
- Class 27: Best Puppy Dog & Reserve.** *Open to the 1st and 2nd place winners of classes 23, 24, 25, & 26. No entry fee.*
- Class 28: Bitch Pups, 6 up to 9 months, smooth.
- Class 29: Bitch Pups, 6 up to 9 months, rough/broken.
- Class 30: Bitch Pups, 9 up to 12 months, smooth.
- Class 31: Bitch Pups, 9 up to 12 months, rough/broken.

- Class 32: **Best Puppy Bitch & Reserve.** *Open to the 1st and 2nd place winners of classes 28, 29, 30 & 31. No entry fee.*
- Class 33: **PUPPY CONFORMATION CHAMPION & RESERVE.** *Open to Best Dog Puppy & Reserve and Best Bitch Puppy & Reserve. No entry fee.*

Section 4. Family

- Class 34: Stud Dog & Get. *Open to a sire with at least 2, but not more than 3 off-spring at parent's side. Judged on Breed Standard and consistency of type. Stud Dog must be an intact male. Get may be intact or spay/neutered.*
- Class 35: Brood Bitch & Produce. *Open to a dam with at least 2, but not more than 3 offspring at parent's side. Brood Bitch must be an intact female. Produce may be intact or spay/neutered. Judged on Breed Standard and consistency of type.*
- Class 36: **BEST FAMILY & RESERVE.** *Open to 1st and 2nd place winners in classes 34 & 35. No entry fee.*
- Class 37: Three Generations Breeders Class. *Open to a minimum of three successive generations of breeding. Judged on conformation and improvement with each generation. (Non-Sanctioned).*

Section 5. Open Adult Conformation – *No cross-entering is permitted within the Open Section. Cross-entering is **not** permitted between the Open Section and the Working Section.*

- Class 38: Bred by Exhibitor Dog. *Open to any terrier owned and bred by the exhibitor; must be handled by the breeder under whose kennel prefix the terrier is registered or a member of that breeder's immediate family.*
- Class 39: Dogs, 1 year and older, 10 up to 12½", smooth.
- Class 40: Dogs, 1 year and older, 10 up to 12½", rough/broken.
- Class 41: Dogs, 1 year and older, over 12½ up to 15", smooth.
- Class 42: Dogs, 1 year and older, over 12½ up to 15", rough/broken.
- Class 43: **Best Dog & Reserve.** *Open to 1st and 2nd place winners of classes 38 through 42. No entry fee.*
- Class 44: Bred by Exhibitor Bitch. *Open to any terrier owned and bred by the exhibitor; must be handled by the breeder under whose kennel prefix the terrier is registered or a member of that breeder's immediate family.*
- Class 45: Bitch, 1 year and older, 10 up to 12½", smooth.
- Class 46: Bitch, 1 year and older, 10 up to 12½", rough/broken.
- Class 47: Bitch, 1 year and older, over 12½ up to 15", smooth.
- Class 48: Bitch, 1 year and older, over 12½ up to 15", rough/broken.
- Class 49: **Best Bitch & Reserve.** *Open to 1st and 2nd place winners of classes 44 through 48. No entry fee.*
- Class 50: **BEST OPEN TERRIER & RESERVE.** *Open to the Best Dog & Reserve and Best Bitch & Reserve. No entry fee.*

Section 6. Miscellaneous - *Open to any adult JRT including those spayed and neutered. Based on breed standard unless otherwise noted.*

- Class 51: Spayed/Neutered Working Terrier. *Open to any adult Spayed/Neutered Jack Russell Terrier, which holds a JRTCA Natural Hunting Certificate.*
- Class 52: Spayed/ Neutered Terrier: *Open to any adult spayed/neutered jack Russell Terrier.*
- Class 53: **Best & Reserve Spay/Neutered Terrier.** *Open to 1st & 2nd place winners of classes 51 & 52. No entry fee.*
- Class 54: Novice. *Open to any adult Jack Russell which has never placed 1st through 4th in an adult regular or 1st in any Novice Conformation Class, at this or ANY prior sanctioned trial.*
- Class 55: Veteran Terrier. *Open to any Jack Russell Terrier six years or older. Judged on the Breed Standard and condition of the dog.*
- Class 56: Russell Rescue Terrier. *Open to any Jack Russell Terrier adopted from Russell Rescue.*

Suitability—Judge’s Choice. *Open to any adult Jack Russell Terrier, including those which have been spayed / neutered. The dog the judge would choose to take hunting to each of the quarry listed below.*

Class 57: Suitability to Red Fox

Class 58: Suitability to Groundhog

Class 59: Suitability to Raccoon/Badger

Division B - Go-To-Ground

- Class 60: **Pre-Novice Puppy.** Open to Jack Russell puppies 4 up to 6 months. Entry in Pre-Novice Puppy class does not affect the puppy’s eligibility to enter the Novice class after 6 months of age. *(One minute to reach quarry; mark quarry for 15 seconds; may leave earth and re-enter.)*
- Class 61: **Novice Puppy-**Open to Jack Russells 6 up to 12 months which have not scored 100% in this class at a previous JTRCA trial. Entries earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Open Puppy class at this trial. *(One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter several times; work quarry for 30 seconds.)*
- Class 62: **Novice Adult-**Open to Jack Russells one year of age or older which have not scored 100% in this class at a previous JRTCA trial. Entries earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Open class at this trial. *(One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter several times; work quarry for 30 seconds.)*
- Class 63: **Open Puppy** - Open to Jack Russells 6 up to 12 months which have scored 100% in a Novice Go-To-Ground class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. Not open to any puppies which have previously achieved 100% in this class. Puppies earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Puppy Championship GTG class at this trial. *(30 seconds to reach quarry; may leave earth once and re-enter; work quarry for one minute).*
- Class 64: **Open Adult** - Open to Jack Russell one year or older which have scored 100% in a Novice Go-To-Ground class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. *(30 seconds to reach quarry; may leave earth once and re-enter; work quarry for one minute.)*
- Class 65: Puppy Championship** - Open to Jack Russell Terriers 6 up to 12 months which have earned 100% in an Open Go-to-Ground class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. A copy of a 100% Open score sheet shall be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. First and second place winners will be Puppy Go-To-Ground Champion and Reserve. *(30 seconds to reach quarry. May leave earth once and re-enter. Work quarry for one minute.)*
- Class 66: 10 up to 12 ½” Championship Certificate.** Open to any adult Jack Russell 10 up to 12 ½”, one year and over, which holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. A copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. . First and second place winners will be Go-To-Ground Champion and Reserve. *(30 seconds to reach quarry; may not leave earth; work quarry for one minute.)*
- Class 67: Over 12 ½ up to 15” Championship Certificate.** Open to any adult Jack Russell over 12 ½ up to 15”, one year and older, which holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. A copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. . First and second place winners will be Go-To-Ground Champion and Reserve. *(30 seconds to reach quarry; may not leave earth; work quarry for one minute.)*
- Class 68: Veteran Champion Certificate** - Open to any adult Jack Russell 6 years of age or older, who holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. **CROSS-ENTERING IS NOT PERMITTED BETWEEN CERTIFICATE CLASSES.** *(30 seconds to reach quarry; may not leave earth; work quarry for one minute.)*

Division C: Super Earth Go-To-Ground

30 seconds per 30 feet of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave and re-enter earth; work quarry for one minute.

Class 69: 6 up to 12 Month Puppy Super Earth. Open to Jack Russell Puppies from 6 to 12 months of age.

Class 70: 10 up to 12 ½" Super Earth. Open to terriers one year and older.

Class 71: 12 ½ up to 15" Super Earth. Open to terriers one year and older.

Class 72: 10 up to 12 ½" Veteran Super Earth. Open to terriers six years and older.

Class 73: 12 ½ up to 15" Veteran Super Earth. Open to terriers six years and older.

Class 74: 10 up to 12 ½" Championship Certificate. Open to any adult Jack Russell 10 up to 12 ½", one year and over, which holds a JRTCA Super Earth Trial Certificate. A copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. . First and second place winners will be Adult Super Earth Champion and Reserve.

Class 75: Over 12 ½ up to 15" Championship Certificate. Open to any adult Jack Russell over 12 ½ up to 15", one year and older, which holds a JRTCA Super Earth Trial Certificate. A copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. . First and second place winners will be Adult Super Earth Champion and Reserve

Class 76: Veteran Champion Certificate - Open to any adult Jack Russell 6 years of age or older, who holds a JRTCA Veteran Super Earth Trial Certificate. A copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. . First and second place winners will be Veteran Super Earth Champion and Reserve. **CROSS-ENTERING IS NOT PERMITTED BETWEEN CERTIFICATE CLASSES.**

Division D - Youth Division

Child and Youth Handler classes will begin at 12:00 in the conformation ring (after racing).

Class 77: **Child Handler.** Open to any youth aged 5 through 9, handling a Jack Russell Terrier, six months of age or older. This class is offered as an introductory experience in handling and learning about the Jack Russell Terrier. Judged on child's ability to present his/her dog and beginning knowledge of the Jack Russell. Quality of the dog NOT to be considered.

Class 78: **Youth Handler.** Open to any youth aged 10 through 16, handling an adult Jack Russell Terrier. Judge on the youth's ability to present his/her dog and knowledge of the Jack Russell Terrier. Quality of the dog NOT to be considered.

Class 79: **Youth G-T-G.** Open to any youth aged 10 through 16, handling an adult Jack Russell Terrier. Judged on the youth's ability to present his/her dog and knowledge of Go-To-Ground. To be run through the 10-foot Novice liner; time not to be considered.

Class 80: **Youth Working Judges Choice:** Open to any youth handler aged 10-16. Judged on the youth's knowledge of hunting and working terriers, and the ability to answer questions presented by a Working Judge; no terrier to accompany handler in class. "Optional"

Class 81: YOUTH HANDLER HIGH SCORE & RESERVE

Awarded to the highest scoring youth and runner-up in classes 78, 79 & 80. The points are awarded as follows: 1st=8 points, 2nd=6 points, 3rd=5 points, 4th=4 points, 5th=3 points, 6th=2 points, and participation=1 point.

Division E: Racing

Starting promptly at 8:30 a.m. All terriers must be muzzled to race. Plastic basket or close-ended cloth muzzles only. No figure eight or open-ended muzzles will be allowed. No cross entering between adult and veteran.
NO POST ENTRIES FOR RACING.

SECTION 1. Flat Races

- Class 82: Pups, 6 up to 9 months, up to 12 ½"
- Class 83: Pups, 6 up to 9 months, over 12½" up to 15"
- Class 84: Pups, 9 up to 12 months, up to 12 ½"
- Class 85: Pups, 9 up to 12 months, over 12½" up to 15"
- Class 86: Dogs, 1 year and older, 10" up to 12½"
- Class 87: Dogs, 1 year and older, over 12½" up to 15"
- Class 88: Bitches, 1 year and older, 10" up to 12 ½"
- Class 89: Bitches, 1 year and older, over 12½" up to 15"
- Class 90: Veterans, 6 years and older, 10" up to 12 ½"
- Class 91: Veterans, 6 years and older, over 12½" up to 15"

SECTION 2. Steeplechase Races

Puppy races over low hurdles, up to 8"

- Class 92: Pups, 6 up to 9 months, up to 12 ½"
